## **Britain continues to relentlessly ignore methane and other pollution laws- to the deaths of its people**

### **Pollution sensors available for 40 years**

Four decades ago in California, United States, a new light sensor was created which could determine if smokestack two miles away was polluting the atmosphere around and what kind of pollution it was. <sup>1</sup>The sensor could reveal how badly polluted the air was as far as eight miles away. The sensor could reveal how fast the pollution might be moving. Such pollution poisons the air with cancer-causing agents. The sensor could trace the amount of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere.

### **The tunable laser radar device**

This sensor, known as a *tunable laser radar device*, capitalises on the versatility of lasers, which focus light in narrow, coherent beams. One man can operate the van equipment, but dozens of ground inspectors are needed to investigate a site of potential pollution.

### **How this pollution-seeking device works**

The laser sends out pulses of light at, high energy at different wavelengths, or frequencies. Each type of gas, pollutant or not, has its own vibration frequency and absorbs the light hitting it. The atmosphere then reflects the light back, like radar. The returning light is gathered in by a 16-inch telescope and measured and analysed by a computer to determine, for example, how much of particular pollutant gas is coming from or hanging over a distant smokestack, for example. The laser beam can be tuned, or changed to transmit at different frequencies, to identify specific molecules. The pulsed laser light goes straight through all gas molecules to those with the right wavelength, and this forty-year old equipment was able to look through water vapour that otherwise might mask the beam. Distance is measured by how long it takes the laser light to travel out and back at 186,000 miles a second.

### **Pollutants the equipment identifies**

This equipment can determine whether stack emissions are within government and international limits so that corrective action takes place. Changes must be made in fuel burning when the day's atmospherics are shown to include a concentration of offensive gases. The pollutant chemicals this 1978 laser identified four decades ago are: methane, sulphur dioxide, nitrous oxide, freon, ethylene, acetic anhydride, benzpyene (aka vinyl chloride). Measuring methane gas escaping from oil and gas deposits and could detect leaks in oil refinery pipe- lines and leaks in liquid natural gas tanks. Sulphur dioxide comes from auto exhausts and causes coughing and later cancer. Acetic anhydride is a gas given off

**when illegal heroin is being manufactured. Nitrous oxide causes fruits and flowers/to ripen prematurely. Benzpyrene or vinyl chloride, when identified, calls for remedial control of air-polluting emissions.**

## **A Residents' Group has warned *for years* about an imminent fire risk in the 24-storey block where hundreds lived: deadly racism in a place near you**

### **Grenfell Tower Block burnt in the early hours: most were asleep**

Grenfell Tower block for poor residents in one and two bedroom flats is situated in Kensington, London, an affluent area with multi-million pound homes nearby. Grenfell was recently given a cosmetic facelift costing over £8 million – mainly to make it look attractive to the wealthy neighbours who were forced to look at it every day as they went to and from their affluent houses nearby. This cosmetic facelift was undertaken and government funded to appease the parallel rich residents in this cachement area who complained that the ugly sight of this poverty stricken, unmaintained tower block building housing poor residents was bringing down the price of their own lavish properties.

### **London: largest financial centre in the world**

We must remember also that despite the tremendous dire poverty of pockets of people living in London- that London is the capital city of the United Kingdom ('UK'). Covering an area of 607 square miles, it is the largest metropolitan area in the United Kingdom. It is located on the River Thames. London is the largest financial centre along with New York in the United States. Fashion, cuisine, tourist places, and art and architecture of London attracts millions of visitors. London is the most-visited city in the world. The Tower of London, Kew Gardens, Palace of Westminster, St Margaret's Church, Buckingham Palace, Piccadilly Circus, and Trafalgar Square are London's major attractions.

### **London in England, UK-one of the largest economies in the world-has millions of poverty-stricken residents**

**One of the largest economies in the world, England has a mixed market economy. Chemicals, pharmaceutical sectors, aerospace, and manufacturing are the major drivers of the economy of England. Owing to a number of beautiful attractions in the country, tourism contributes to the finances of England.**

**IP law is onerous, complex and stressful and hampers paediatric medicine from getting to market. England is a paradise for legal loophole lawyers who are hard-wired to think in that fashion. ### **Holocaust wish among London’s wealthy**



### **The tragic destruction of Grenfell Tower Block and death of dozens of people in the early hours of the morning in London, UK**

## **Tower block fire destroyed Grenfell Tower and its poor residents**

**It has now been exposed that the London, Kensington's Grenfell Tower Block's residents' association and another residents' group *Grenfell Action Group*, had warned in blog posts and to the government housing authorities that there would be a catastrophic imminent fire risk in this building.**



**The government placated the residents by paying for an external 'facelift' of the building costing several million pounds, which facelift itself is now being queried as aiding the forceful spread of the fire which burned for over 24 hours.**

### **A PLETHORA of Health and Safety offences here**

**This serious and major fire has quickly been acknowledged as a health and safety crime (against the 500 or more residents) by the government and building contractors who caused so many deaths. After 18 hours of the tower block burning away, there were 12 known deaths of residents of Grenville Tower Block with 79 persons known to be in various London hospitals, with over 20 very seriously burnt. The residents were utterly desperate as the fire swept through the 24 blocks of apartments in**

**Grenfell Action Group. Firemen told residents to stay put in their apartments until rescuers reached them. Luckily many ignored this order and ran for their lives.**

**Criminal offences are not only committed by individual people, but also by companies in the case of a regulatory offence. A company is in English law a legal person. A group of companies is in English law a legal person. Even if the cladding company were charged, tried and convicted of corporate manslaughter of the dozens of people killed at Grenfell Tower Block in Kensington, London, such a company will only face a fine, which the company will simply pass on in prices to customers. The man in the street will again pay such a fine because in a criminal prosecution, the burden of proof lies with the prosecution and it is taxpayers who pay the police and Crown Prosecution officers' salaries.**

**Nonetheless many regulatory, supervisory, and quality control offences have been committed which directly cause the destruction of Grenfell Tower and its inhabitants. By not adequately maintaining this high-rise building housing hundreds of poor families, the successive governments from 1974 to 2017 have themselves committed crimes. They omitted to bring the building up to current regulatory requirements year after year after year- they committed crimes of not maintaining their social responsibility, well stated by Steven Heyman who said:**

**'The state is a community whose ends include the protection of its members from criminal violence and other serious harm. Every citizen has a fundamental right to protection by the community. In return the individual has an obligation to assist in performing this function by acting when necessary to rescue a fellow citizen in danger. This duty is owed not only to the community at large but also to the other**

members of the community, especially the endangered person. An individual who breaches this obligation can properly be held responsible both to the community through its criminal law and to the injured party in a tort action.’

## **Legal Exemptions for older buildings are illogical Sprinkler systems and escape fire wells were non-existent**

### **The Compliant British**

The British are culturally known for following rules, queuing, etc, and dozens who awoke with the noise died because they were told to stay in their apartments until Fire Rescue Service reached their floor, whilst fire engulfed all floors. Many others were asleep and died in their very beds – like the Holocaust victims who went into the shower spaces in Poland’s Auschwitz Concentration Vamps expecting to feel warm water but instead breathed in poisonous gases which killed them instantly.

It is hearsay that the fire started by an electrical fault in a refrigerator in an apartment on the fourth floor and although the fire rescue service arrived within minutes of a telephone call about Grenfell House on fire, they had no fire suitable rescue vehicles because none of their ladders or water hoses reached higher than the twelfth floor.

If one considers the recent terrorist offences in the United Kingdom, the whole of London is at risk merely due to no high ladders to reach people say at the City of London’s *gherkin high rise building*<sup>i</sup>. However, the difference between Grenfell Tower

*Block for poverty stricken residents and the elitist Gherkin City Office building has high technology sprinkler systems, automatic electronic alerts to security agencies and the best that money can buy.*



## **The pariah scams that are the English organised Charity sector**

Like the money-laundering fraudsters that prey on people's sympathy, the English organised charities soon were seen on British television, telling people to send money to them.
